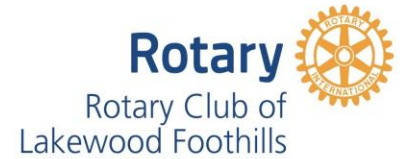


RESPONSES TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

March 24, 2022



Guiding Principles:

- The position of Rotary International is that all Rotarians who can be vaccinated for COVID-19 should be vaccinated.
- Guidelines or regulations regarding “public events” do not necessarily apply to our club because Rotary events are private events. However our responses will at least meet the standards of those issued by public entities.
- The Club’s Board of Directors can set expectations, norms, or standards for all Rotarians and non-Rotarians regarding participating safely in club activities.

Rotary Club of Lakewood Foothills COVID Safety Protocols

Requirements to participate in person – REVISED March 8, 2022

Those attending Club activities are encouraged to be fully vaccinated with a CDC authorized COVID vaccine;

In addition:

If you are sick in general, stay at home and participate by Zoom; or

If you have tested positive for COVID or have COVID symptoms, stay at home and participate by Zoom; or

If you have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID, or has COVID symptoms, stay at home and participate by Zoom.
